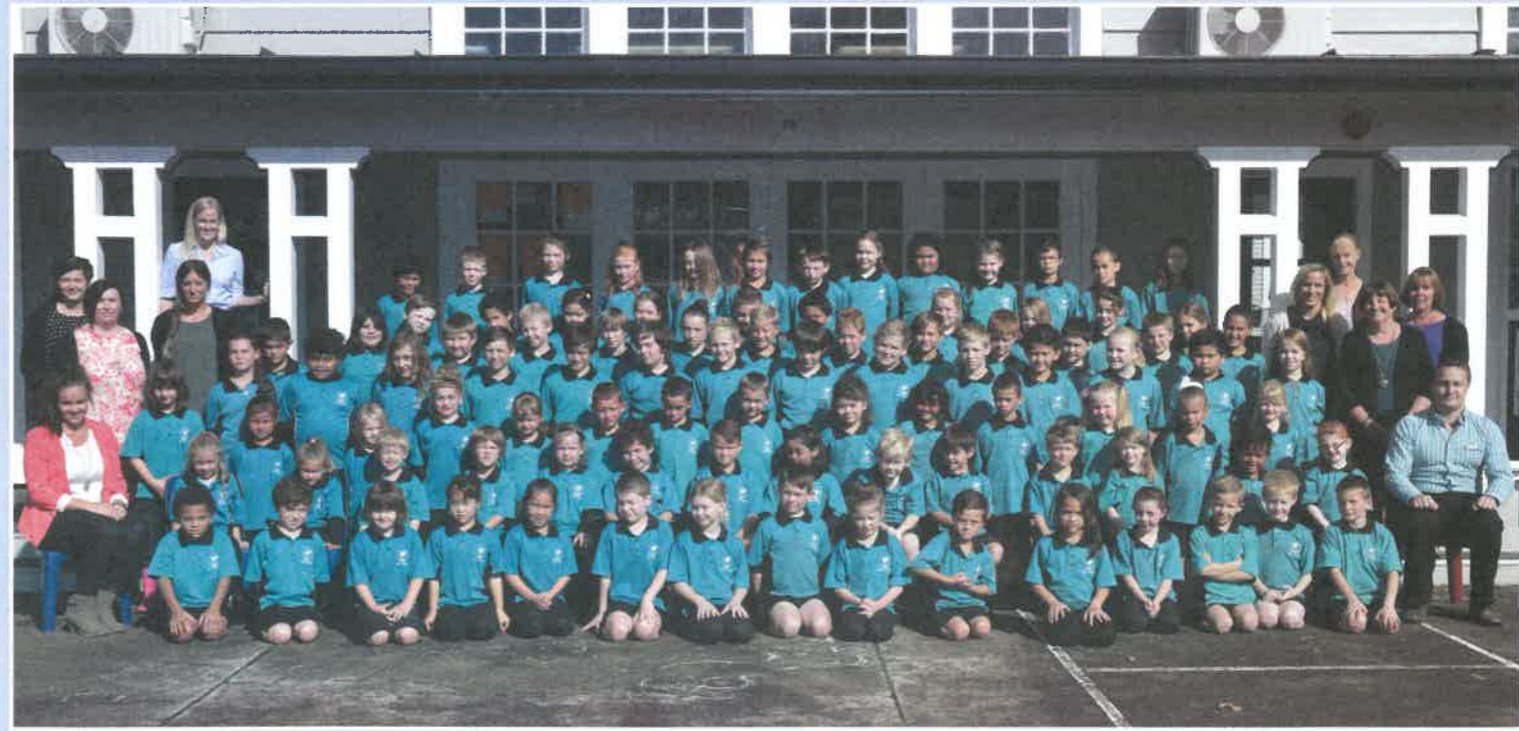

LEARNING AT TIRAU SCHOOL – CROSS COUNTRY

This year we have made the decision to hold our School Cross Country at James and Ella Bailey’s Farm just off Momona Road North of Tirau. The course gives the children the chance to be part of a real cross country with some running through ditches and up and down some hills. Miss White has worked with Mrs Bardoul to design a course that gives the children a real experience with some challenge which is important as the Interschool cross country held at Te Waotu is run over hills and farmland. Because this is a working farm there are important health and safety expectations that must be followed by all the students and spectators.

- **Children must wear covered footwear to take part in the cross country.** - The children will be running through fields with thistles and uneven ground. The ground will also be soft underfoot.
- **Warm clothes to wear before and after their race is also advised, as well as water to keep your child hydrated.**
- **The children will be seated in designated areas and supervised before and after their races** and it is **important that parents do not take them away** during the running of the cross country as the teachers and adults supervising them must know where they are at all times.
- **The children will be transported to and from the cross country by bus and will be supervised by staff at all times.**
- **No child will be allowed to be taken home** from the farm. If you would like to take your child home after the cross country then you can pick them up from school once the buses have returned. **Please speak to your child’s teacher before taking your child.**
- **The cross country will be held in one paddock – all participants and spectators must stay in this area and not wander to other areas of the farm. Out of bounds areas include wool shed, implement shed, hay barns, farm vehicles and are essentially any place or object that lies beyond the course/track or parking area. Boundaries will be discussed on the day and tracks will be marked and marshalls will be on the course.**
- **Spectators must stay within the designated paddock and are not to enter the farm unless assigned a supervising job.**
- **If bringing toddlers or other children with you as spectators** please be aware that **they must be supervised at all times** as there are hazards present and these could present a danger to children. **Please do not allow them to run around, especially when walking to and from the parking area by the woolshed.**
- **Parking will be available up at the woolshed and toilet facilities will be available near the course.**
- **Hazards that you need to be aware of:**
 - Water troughs – in the paddock where the cross country is being held and in surrounding area –
 - Farm vehicles
 - Stock
 - A boundary fence is electrified
 - Farm buildings and equipment
- **Steps have been taken to eliminate and minimize these hazards and all spectators must follow the instructions of the staff and parents running the event.**
- **Tanya Putt will be the designated first aid officer – in the event of any accident or near miss please report to her so it can be assessed, treated and recorded.**
- **In case of an emergency the gazebos on site will be the assembly area and it is important that everyone reports there quickly and then follows the organizers instructions.**
